

Events & activities conducted in the Academic Year 2017-18

SICS believes in overall grooming of the students. So, we have conducted various cocurricular and extra-curricular activities in AY 2017-18 apart from the teaching modules of the University. The activities include Inbound, Outbound, Guest Lecture, Seminars, Industrial Visit, Essay competition, cultural fest etc. Few of the events are as below-

- Inbound Activities: conducted on 27th July 2017 at SASMIRA Auditorium for the first year students, (batch of 2017-20) during Induction session. The activities was conducted by SICS faculties with the help of 2nd year students. Main aim was to introduce the new students among themselves and to find out the talent among the group.
- ➤ Ganesh Idol Making: Organised workshop on Eco Friendly Ganesh Idols making under the guidance of Mr. Promod Davkate (Student of BSc. IT) on 12th Aug, 2017.
- ➤ Out Bound: One day event Organised on 16th Sept 2017, at Worli Sports Club, Worli for SICS students. It was organised by the company "Team Indiya, Pune" who had conducted various management games for the students. Approximately 200 student participated in the events.
- Swachtta Bharat Abhiyan: Considering the slogan of "Mahatma Gandhi" on Swachtta Abhiyan,, SICS students have paid respect to "Mahatma Gandhi" on 26th Sept 2017, by arranging a rally from College campus to Worli Sea Face and conducted a Street Play highlighting the awareness of Cleanliness.
- ➤ NGO Mela: The event was conducted in association with SASMIRA institute of Management Studies and Research (SIMSR) on 13th Oct 2017, where SICS students raised funds for 22 NGO's by contributing old newspaper and selling the products of the various NGO's.
- ➤ Traditional Day: Traditional Day was held on 19th Dec 2017 in the college auditorium. It was an eventful day designated for students to come in traditional attire from their home state or any culture of their choice.
- Christmas Celebration: On 25th of December, 2017, SICS celebrated both Christmas and New Year. To set a perfect example of secularism, we celebrate all the festivals in our college.
- Blood Donation Drive: A Blood donation camp was organised by SICS on 5th January 2018(Friday). The blood donation drive was organised in collaboration with Breach Candy Hospital one of the most renewed and prestigious hospital.



- Short Term Certificate Course on "Basics of Investment & Stock Market": 6 days short term courses were conducted for SICS students from 6th Jan 2018 to 13th Jan 2018. Total 104 students were registered for the course. The lecture session was managed by Mr.Ashok Dhingreja, visiting faculty of SICs who is also associated to Stock Market and working as Full time faculty in Poddar College. He is also a Practitioner lawyer at Bombay High Court. The students were given certificate after successfully completion of the course.
- Excel Training: Training of Excel was arranged for SICS students on 16th Jan 2018. Mr. Vijay Nag, CEO and Founder of the company "Intrepidians" had taken the training. He is an Ex- Employee of Microsoft & Oracle. Training was for both first and second year students of SICS.
- Republic Day: 26th of January, 2018 is a gala day for every Indian. On 26th January 1950, the constitution of India becomes the Republic. We celebrate this day as a festival every year. On the behalf of SICS, the 68th Republic day of our nation was celebrated in a colourful and grand manner.
- ➤ Industrial Visit (I.V): first year and second students of SICS had visited to Ooty-Mysore-Bangalore for Industrial Visit for 7 days from 31st Jan 2018 to 7th Feb 2018. Total 131 students alongwith 4 faculties had gone for I.V. It was a great learning alongwith practical real life experiences for the students. The company visited during the period were "Mysore Sandal Soap, IIM Bangalore, Doddabetta Tea Factory-Ooty, Teolet Technology- Bangalore and Mysore Silk Factory". The students were also taken for site visit at various locations like Botanical Garden, Maysore Palace, Lambs Rock etc.
- > Annual Fest: SICS has its first Annual Fest "SASMIRA Spontania" was successfully organised for 3 days from 22nd Feb 2018 to 24th Feb 2018. Various activities including indoor and Outdoor games were scheduled along with cultural events. All the events except Foot Ball were conducted at Intra -College level in which students from all the colleges of SASMIRA were participated. Only one game "Football Tournament" was at Inter-Collegiate level where total 16 teams from other colleges were participated. The tournament was organised at Worli Sports Club, Worli. Winner of the Football Tournament was "St. Andrew's College, Bandra" and runner up was "Vidyalankar Coolege, Vadala:. The whole program was organised on sponsorship basis.
